Specific Regulations of the Department of Computer Science to the General Doctoral Regulations of the TU Darmstadt (§10 (1)):

Doctoral candidates are granted the right to suggest a doctoral mentor who accompanies its doctoral students in addition to the first supervisor in all questions during the doctoral thesis project (e.g. questions regarding the course of the doctorate, career development).

The doctoral mentor is suggested by the doctoral candidate and must have at least a completed doctorate and should not be dependent on the first supervisor.

The doctoral mentor usually is a professor or a postdoc of TU Darmstadt.
