



## Admission as a Doctoral Student and Aptitude Assessment Process

According to §7 (5) of our General Doctoral Regulations it is possible that applicants with a degree other than in the field of informatics may also be admitted as a doctoral student in the interest of interdisciplinary research and in case the qualification for the area of doctoral study has been assured.

The Doctoral Examination Board decides on the admittance of such applicants as well as if additional courses are required. Applicants from outside the field of informatics additionally need the following documents:

- Statement of your supervising professor
- List of qualifications in the field of informatics (acquired either during studies or occupation) together with the required documents (certificates and proof of qualification with short detailed explanation).
