M. Angela Sasse is the professor Human-Centred Security at Ruhr-University Bochum in Germany. She is one of the pioneers of usable security research – the 1999 paper “Users are not the Enemy” (co-authored with Anne Adams) is the most cited publication on usable security. In recent years, her research focus has been empirical research on how large organisations manage cybersecurity risks, and how inaccurate assumptions, misaligned incentives and lack of accountability lead to sub-optimal decisions . She is a fellow of the UK Royal Academy of Engineering and the German National Academy of Sciences “Leopoldina”.
