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# Organization of Seminar Sessions



- 1 hour 40 minutes each Tuesday, starting May 5th
  - 3 separate presentation on a single resource (15 min. each).
  - 1 joint presentation where the resources of a common topic are discussed and compared (15 min). The presentation should be created together but only presented by one student. The joint presentation should also include an overview of resources that share the common topic, but were not explicitly presented.
- Missing more than 2 sessions requires an excuse, otherwise you will fail the seminar.

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# Grades



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- Single presentation will account for 30% of the grade.
    - The joint presentation will also be taken into account!
  - The report you have to deliver at the end of the semester will account for 70% of the grade. Every participant has to write her/his own report, 12 pages are required.
  - We will be grateful for example applications using the API of a platform (if available)
